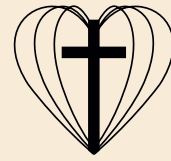

# FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

## CCA Special Initiatives

**Nutritional Development Services (NDS):** The need for food and food-related resources has grown significantly, affecting more individuals and children than ever before. In response, NDS expanded its reach to support those in need. **We are thrilled to share that during the Thanksgiving season, \$242,420 was raised through 3,036 generous gifts as part of this essential partnership between the CCA and NDS.**

**Schools of Special Education:** The Archdiocese of Philadelphia's three Schools of Special Education continue to provide exceptional care for God's most vulnerable children. **Through the remarkable generosity of donors like you, over \$226,519 was contributed through more than 3,036 gifts.** This past year presented many challenges, but your unwavering support ensured that children continued to receive the highest level of Catholic education, offering peace of mind to countless families.

**Catholic Housing and Community Services:** In a time when fear and uncertainty impacted many in our senior community, the need to support vital programs like Catholic Housing and Community Services was paramount. This initiative provides seniors with housing, meals, in-home support, mental health services, and more. **Thanks to your extraordinary generosity, \$182,237 was raised through 2,349 gifts, bringing hope and care to our beloved seniors.**

The Catholic Charities Appeal is committed to transparency and stewardship of your gifts. This is why we do our best to keep fundraising, administrative and investment fees low. With all expenditures included, the Appeal operates at an average efficiency of \$0.16 cents per dollar raised. As a recognized authority, the Better Business Bureau indicates that total fundraising expenses do not exceed \$0.35 cents per dollar raised. While the Catholic Charities Appeal's total costs are considerably below this benchmark, we continuously strive for additional fundraising efficiencies.

## BENEFICIARY HIGHLIGHTS

**"Thanks to the generosity of Catholic Charities Appeal donors, the Office of Persons with Disabilities expanded its programming to include a bilingual, English/Spanish retreat for families with children with disabilities for the first time.** During the Path of Hope retreat, activities were provided for children while their families were spiritually fed through the retreat sessions offered in their native language.

Additionally, the Mass for Persons with Disabilities, the Deaf Community, family, friends, and caregivers was a beautiful celebration of the gifts that individuals with disabilities have and how they share those gifts with others. The reception following the Mass always allows for an opportunity to experience the joy of community when all are truly valued and have a sense of belonging. ## BENEFICIARY HIGHLIGHTS

"St. Lucy School provides a family atmosphere to children with visual impairments. There is something special about the teachers, staff, and children that gather here. Everyone is so supportive of one another. In most educational placements, students with visual impairments may be the only child in a classroom or school who uses a cane or reads braille. At St. Lucy School, children learn side by side with other students who are experiencing challenges with their vision. Because of this unique program, students help one another to learn and grow. Many of the families who attend St. Lucy's do not have the financial means to send their child here, yet they need the benefits of the program that St. Lucy School provides. St. Lucy School offers an academic education with all the support for students to access educational materials through the use of magnification, braille, assistive technology, and tactile models in order to meet their learning needs.

### Day of Service

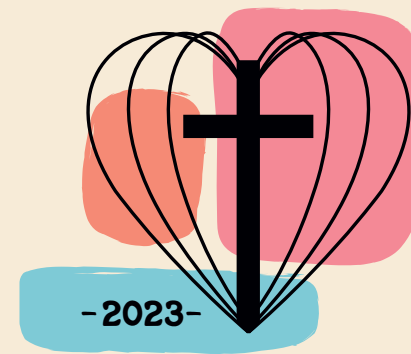

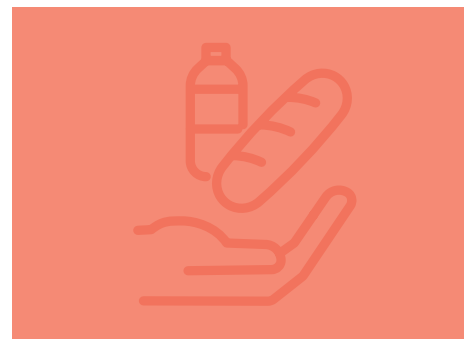

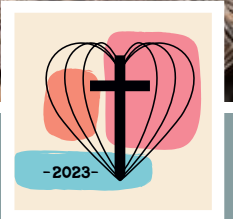
