GENERAL INFORMATION

PURPOSE:

This toolkit is designed to support parishes of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia in their final efforts to help the Catholic Charities Appeal reach its \$10 million goal by the end of the year. With more than \$7.7 million raised so far, we are relying on the generosity of our parish communities to meet this critical target.

KEY DATES:

- November 18-December2: #iGiveCatholic Advanced Giving Phase
- November 28: Thanksgiving
- December 1: First Sunday of Advent
- December 3: #iGiveCatholic Takes Place across the Archdiocese of Philadelphia
- December 7-8: Speaker Weekend

ACTION STEPS FOR PARISHES:

- **Highlight CCA During Thanksgiving Masses (November 28)**: Encourage parishioners to reflect on their blessings and consider supporting CCA to help those in need. Share a brief message or prayer of gratitude for their generosity.
- Promote #iGiveCatholic on Giving Tuesday (December 3): Share information about the Giving Day in bulletins, on social media, and during Mass announcements.
- Invite a Speaker the weekend of December 7-8: Host a speaker at weekend Masses to share personal stories about the impact of the Catholic Charities Appeal.
- Incorporate the CCA Video in Parish Communications: Show the CCA video during Mass, or include the link in parish emails and social media posts.
- **Encourage In-Pew Giving**: Distribute CCA envelopes and set aside time during Mass for parishioners to contribute.
- Leverage Bulletin Announcements and Inserts: Include a pre-designed CCA message in your bulletins throughout Advent.
- Send Parish-wide Emails and Post on Social Media: Share reminders about CCA, emphasizing the urgency of meeting the year-end goal.
- Include CCA in Advent Prayers and Petitions: Offer special intentions during Mass for those served by CCA.

WHAT IS #IGIVECATHOLIC?

WHEN IS #IGIVECATHOLIC?

Donations will be collected online at www.igivecatholic.org starting with the Advanced Giving phase on Monday, November 18th through 11:59pm of the giving day. Offline gifts of cash or check may be collected and added to the campaign total throughout the online giving period and for an additional week following the giving day, but must be entered into the participant organization's dashboard by 11:59 on December 10th to be counted in this year's totals.
