We have had three generations attend St. Lucy's Day School for Children with Visual Impairments. My mother was part of the first graduating class, I started here in Kindergarten and now my daughter, Kimberly, attends St. Lucy's.

At birth, Kimberly was diagnosed with congenital motor nystagmus. I knew there was no other place for her to go - she was coming here to St. Lucy's. I knew she would get the Catholic education I wanted for her and they would be able to help her in any way she needed. They have the technology and equipment that Kimberly needs; if she is having an issue everything is here for her. The kids at St. Lucy's also integrate over to Holy Innocents for regular classes, for lunch, and in the school yard.

I don't know what I would have done without this school. St. Lucy's is a place to learn and grow, but more than that, it's a family. You are welcome here with open arms.
